Word Definitions

“Comforter” refers to one who is summoned, called to one’s side, esp. called to one’s aid. When we need help the Holy Spirit is ever by our side to give us the aid we need. He is our Comforter and Friend.

Question to Ponder:

- What does the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit mean to you personally?
- What is the benefit of the Holy Spirit dwelling within us?

Main Point of Today’s Lesson

49 I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.
